



Happy New Year !

Lassen Humane Society had a pretty good 2014 ending with our Christmas wreath fundraiser. We made and sold over 150 wreaths and swags, bringing in approximately \$7500. Thanks to everyone who helped with the project, and of course to everyone who purchased. Our successful fundraising will enable us to continue our basic spay/neuter assistance program. In 2014 we spent over \$38,000 to help get more than 600 dogs and cats altered. We're still searching for grant funding, but for now, we can at least continue our basic program.

Pups on Parole

Adoptions from the Pups on Parole program are still slow, but the program remains effective and popular. In 2014, we placed 24 dogs into forever homes. If you or someone you know is looking for a great dog, just check out our candidates on petfinder.com.

Spay/Neuter Assistance

While we still have no grant funding for dog and cat spay/neuter assistance, we continue to be able to provide help to low income Lassen County residents. You make an appointment with your vet (Susanville or Chester), and when you take the animal in for surgery, let the vet know that you wish to take advantage of the Humane Society's program. They'll give you a short form to complete, then they'll bill us for \$50 of the surgery fee. You will be responsible for payment of the balance. If you use an out of the area vet, you must pay the full bill, then request reimbursement from us. This program is subject to cancellation without notice.

Volunteers

A huge thank you to all of the volunteers who helped make last year's fundraisers so successful. We hope you all will continue to support us this year, and bring along anyone else who you know would like to help out. We work hard, but also have lots of fun putting together our projects.

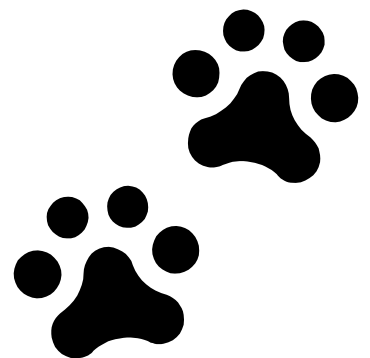
